RE: Protest of Application – 19 Proposed Wells Between Black Ridge and Hurricane

Anyone interested in filing a Protest of Application with the Utah Division of Water Rights can do so by using one of the following methods:

1) Go to the Utah Division of Water Rights website. Under Resources on the right-hand side of the page select “Applications, Forms”. Then again on the right-hand side of the page under Miscellaneous Applications select “Protest of Application”. The Water Right number is 81-5491. Fill out form and pay \$15 fee online. **Must include \$15 fee in order to consider your application complete.**

2) Write a letter addressed to the Division of Water Rights, 1594 West North Temple, Suite 220, PO Box 146300, Salt Lake City, UT 84114-6300. Include the following information in your letter: Water Right #81-5491, Action to be Protested: 19 Proposed Wells Between Black Ridge and Hurricane UT, First and Last Name, Mailing Address, Phone Number, Email Address, are you Requesting a Hearing, and the Reasons for Protesting. **Must include \$15 fee in order to consider your application complete.**

Both the online application and/or written letter must be received with your \$15 fee on/before Wednesday, April 27th. At this point you don’t need to own any water rights to protest this action.
